| $\begin{aligned} & \text { NOVICE } \\ & 12 \text { to } 20 \\ & \text { skaters } \end{aligned}$ | Novice: all skaters, except for 4 maximum, must have reached the age of 8 but not have reached the age of 15 by July 1st of the competition year. The 4 skaters "Outside criterion" may be outside the age range by 3 years maximum ( 5 years old minimum for the youngest, less than 18 years old for the oldest, by July1st of the competition year). | Choreographic exercise : 2'30 + free program 4'30 +/- 10 seconds |
|  | The same number of skaters must compete in the CE and FS. But 4 Skaters who are on the roster may change from the CE and FS. | No test required |

Senior, Junior, Novice : from 12 (minimum) to 20 (maximum) skaters in competition. Novice, Junior and Senior teams may have a roaster from 12 to 24 skaters. (maximum number of skaters on the ice for EC and FS is 20).
